



LAW

This course involves the study of the legal system in England and Wales. Students gain an overview of how the civil and criminal courts work, and learn about the part played by both legal and lay personnel. In the A2 part of the course, students study the law of tort in greater depth.

This course is appropriate not just for those who wish to study Law at university. It is also extremely useful in the understanding of such subjects as History, Government and Politics, and Business.
